What is Phantom® termiticide-insecticide?

- **Phantom** is registered with the EPA for pre-construction and post-construction termite treatments nationwide, and is applied only by trained, **Phantom** certified professionals.
- **Phantom** is the only undetectable liquid termite control available in New York.
- **Phantom** combines nonrepellency, superior control, long-lasting effects, and the ability to control populations faster than bait systems – all in a low-dose, virtually odorless formulation.

How Phantom Works

- **Phantom**, with the active ingredient chlorphenapyr, kills termites by ingestion and contact. Pests cannot smell it, taste it, or avoid it, so they unknowingly contact and ingest **Phantom** during routine activities.
- **Phantom** has very low water solubility, which means it binds very tightly to the soil and is less likely to be washed out of treated areas.
- Mode of action
 - **Phantom** attacks pests from inside their own bodies by preventing their cells from generating energy, leading to paralysis and death. The process is not instantaneous, pests go about their regular routines for a short time before dying.
 - **Phantom** eliminates pest build up in any one area. Such a build up of dead bugs normally causes other bugs to avoid the treated area.
- **Phantom**'s high potency lessens dosage requirements, meaning a little goes a long way.
